- Pizza & Froyo sponsorships: \$4687 so far (64 froyo and 83 pizza lunches donated)
- School is also providing hot lunches on Fridays

9. Grad Committee - Kristy

- Starting budget approved for \$500
- Second meeting was held with a much better turnout (THANK YOU PARENTS!!)
 - o We had 25 parents sign up through the <u>link to volunteer</u> or coordinate in various capacities.
 - o Willingdon Grad Committee FB Group has 34 members
- Subcommittees have begun to be formed and break-off meetings start later this week:

- Froyo

- Next grad meeting TBD hopefully between Nov 28- Dec 4th for all subcommittees to check in and update
- Parents at our second meeting and in the FB group agreed that a direct ask should be our first step before planning fundraising activities

- Next major step: running Spiritwear school-wide to fund the purchase of the hoodies. Dates TBD @ Nov 5th meeting.

10. Other Business

- School photos Make up photo date Nov 12. Proofs distributed Nov 2. Feedback so far is good.
- Book Fair in person for kids only on November 24th. Online will run simultaneously.
- Froyo first Froyo on Nov 18 grad team working on logistics. Lists are ready.
- Pizza lunches first Pizza lunch on Nov 5th. Isabelle helping with pizzas. Pizza also offered to teachers and staff.
- Santa's Bus is booked for December 16 for cycle 1 students (k,1,2). Show is 30mins. Working on other events for other grades in the New Year.
 - Kindergarten Holiday Event festive culture neutral magic show proposed for Dec 20th (45 mins) with Danys Hamel. Hot chocolate stand was offered as well, also for the teachers (budget \$750-\$850)
- H&S general fundraisers:
 - Pizza lunches so far \$15,349 (457 orders/kids) (cost ~\$9000, so \$6349 profit general fund)
 - Froyo (split with grad) so far \$12180 (453 orders/kids) (cost \sim \$6099.60, so \sim \$6081 split between H&S and Grad).
